15 by the Planning Commission be submitted to Council; and

17 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission is required to review and provide a
18 recommendation for all Preliminary Subdivision Plans in the City of Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio;

21 WHEREAS, on December 17, 2019, the Planning Commission approved The Towns at
22 Steels Corners Preliminary Subdivision Plat on Parcels 35-03697, 35-03632 and 56-12747
23 for the construction of 46 residential lots consisting of 46 single-family attached dwellings
24 clustered into eight buildings, associated public rights-of-way, landscaping, stormwater
25 management, and open space; and

27 WHEREAS, development of the subdivision will require construction of a new public
28 street to be called North Steels Circle, which is located off E. Steels Corners Rd. within the
29 City of Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio.



6 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE

25 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts,
26 according to law, with The Thrasher Group for professional engineering services for the replacement of
27 waterlines in Magnolia and Loomis Avenues.

29 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same
30 from the Water Fund, line item, Capital Outlay.
31

32 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
33 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which
34 have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
35

36 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
37 to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations
38 of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the
39 public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

41 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
42 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and
43 the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected
44 or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by
45 the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.

15 WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Natural Resources Office of Coastal Management
16 administers financial assistance for coastal management purposes; and

18 WHEREAS, a grant is available from the Ohio Department of Natural Resources Ohio Coastal
19 Management Program to support projects which will protect Lake Erie coastal resources; and

21 WHEREAS, the grant requires an estimated local cost share match of 50% of the total project
22 cost; and

24 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls desires financial assistance through the Ohio
25 Department of Natural Resources Coastal Management Assistance Program to construct a trail and
26 trailhead in the Mud Brook Greenway.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
29 Summit and State of Ohio that:

31 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is authorized to apply for a grant from the Ohio
32 Department of Natural Resources Coastal Management Assistance Program to prepare the Mill
33 Pond Dredge Material Beneficial Reuses Study.
34

35 Section 2. The Director of Public Services, Director of Community Development Department,
36 Director of Law, and other city officials, as appropriate, are hereby authorized and directed to
37 execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all
38 information and to execute, certify or furnish such other documents and do all other things, as are
39 necessary for and incidental to carrying out the grant application and this ordinance.

41 Section 3. The City of Cuyahoga Falls does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily
42 complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms and
43 conditions of the Coastal Management Assistance Program, including the local cost share match of
44 50% of the total project cost.

46 Section 4. Any other ordinance and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
47 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of
48 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed
49 are hereby ratified and confirmed.

51 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
52 relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that
53 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action
54 were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the
55 extent applicable, Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

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Section 6.
