7 AN ORDINANCE CREATING A SUPERVISORY POSITION IN THE
8 DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION AND ABOLISHING THE
9 POSITIONS OF PARKS SUPERVISOR AND NATATORIUM MAINTENANCE
10 SUPERVISOR IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION AND
11 AMENDING EXHIBIT "A" OF ORDINANCE 116-2018, AND DECLARING
12 AN EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Department serves the citizens of Cuyahoga Falls; and

16 WHEREAS, the services required to operate parks facilities at the highest expected level necessitate
17 the creation of this position; and

18
19 WHEREAS, these positions are included in the 2019 budget.

20
21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
22 Summit, and State of Ohio that:

23
24 Section 1. The non-bargaining classified position of Manager of Operations is hereby created and
25 established in non-bargaining pay range 29.

27 Section 2. The positions of Parks Supervisor and Natatorium Maintenance Supervisor are hereby
28 abolished.

31 Section 3. The Exhibit 'A' to Ordinance 116-2018 is hereby amended to reflect the changes in
32 position and pay grade classification as set forth in this ordinance.

34 Section 4. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
35 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which
36 have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

37
38 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
39 to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations
40 of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the
41 public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

42
43 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
44 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and
45 the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected
46 or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by
47 the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
