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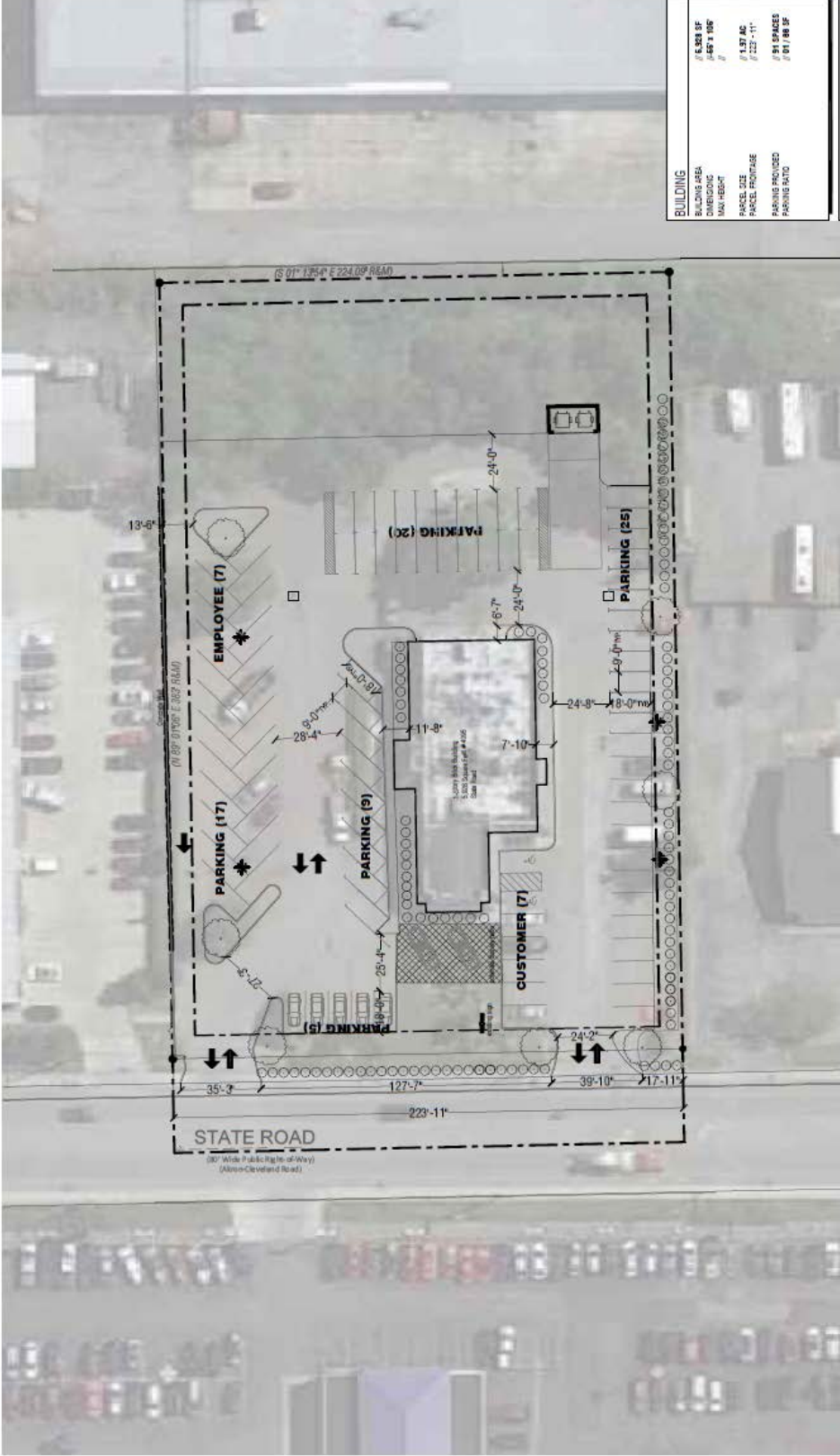

10 PARCEL 02-00234 (2404 7TH STREET) FROM R4 URBAN
11 DENSITY RESIDENTIAL TO MU4 SUB-URBAN CORRIDOR, AS
12 MORE FULLY DESCRIBED AND DEPICTED HEREIN AND

15 WHEREAS, the Charter of the City of Cuyahoga Falls requires that all decisions made by the Planning
16 Commission be submitted to Council, and

17
18 WHEREAS, on November 4, 2020 the Planning Commission considered a zoning map amendment
19 from R4-Urban Density Residential to MU4 Sub-Urban Corridor for parcel 02-00234 (2404 7th Street)
20 and recommended approval. The zoning map amendment parcel is 0.156 acres. The map amendment
21 will allow the applicant, Karl Warther, to include parcel 02-00234 in the development site for the
22 construction of a new Dairy Queen restaurant.

23
24 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission recommended the map amendment based on conceptual plans
25 and findings more fully described in Project File MAP-20-00041, and

26
27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
28 Summit, and State of Ohio:

30 Section 1. That the zoning classification for parcel 02-00234 is hereby changed from R4-Urban

9 FILE BY PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION OF
10 VARIOUS TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, AND

13 WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established
14 and maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and
15 maintained by the Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified
16 Ordinances; and

18 WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the
19 Traffic Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council.

24 Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic
25 Control File is hereby amended as follows:

27 1. Move the "No Parking between these Signs" sign located at 2115 10th
28 Street on the east side of the street to 2103 10th Street, remaining on
29 the east side.
- 30 2. Prohibit parking on the south side of Ashland Avenue between 644 and
31 700 Ashland Avenue.
- 32 3. Prohibit parking on the curve across from 725 Ashland Avenue on
33 Ashland at the intersection of Ashland Avenue and Charles Street.
- 34 4. Prohibit parking on east side of Alanson Circle.
- 35 5. Update the traffic file for Redwood Development as follows:
36 - Prohibit parking on the even side of Redwood Drive
37 - Prohibit parking on the even side of Aspen Place
38 - Prohibit parking on the even side of Poplar Lane
- 39 6. Update the traffic file for Woodland Preserve as follows:
40 - Prohibit parking on the south side of West Woodland Drive
41 - Prohibit parking on the south side of South Woodland Drive
42 - Prohibit parking on the south side of East Woodland Drive
- 43 7. Prohibit parking on the west side of North Steels Circle.
- 44 8. Prohibit parking by posting signage "No Parking Here to Corner" 200
45 feet from the Cedar Hill/Cedar Woods Drive intersection on the north
46 side of Cedar Woods Drive.
- 47 9. Prohibit parking at the dead end of Prange drive on school days from
48 7:00 AM – 4:00 PM.

49 Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to note in the
50 Traffic Control File the proper legends.

52 Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the
53 installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.
