8 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 945.06 OF THE
9 CODIFIED ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

12 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls sets the prices for services within its
13 cemeteries by ordinance; and,

14
15 WHEREAS, the services should fairly represent the amount of time and labor
16 required to accomplish them; and,

17
18 WHEREAS, the cost and labor required to disinter cremains is significantly less
19 than the cost and labor required to disinter a coffin.

20
21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
22 County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

23
24 Section 1. That Section 945.06(a) of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Cuyahoga Falls is
25 hereby amended as follows (new text double underlined):

27 945.06 CHARGES ESTABLISHED; RECORDS.

29 (a) The following rates shall be in existence and apply uniformly throughout the City
30 cemeteries, effective upon passage of this chapter:

67 Section 2. These changes shall be effective as of January 1, 2016.

69 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
70 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not
71 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified
72 and confirmed.

73
74 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
75 concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting
76 of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that
77 resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with
78 all requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

79
80 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
81 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
82 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the
83 affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall
84 take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;
85 otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
